The gta Archives are open Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 1:30 to 5:00 p.m., but only by prior appointment in writing. The best way to contact us is by our [online request](#). Visitors from abroad may be granted special conditions. It is also possible to make research enquiries in writing. In principle our archival materials are only sent out, on loan, for exhibitions. Requests for loans must reach the Archives at the latest six months prior to the beginning of the period of loan.

The use of items on landscape architecture and spatial planning held by NSL Archives (gta) is subject to special regulations and only possible by appointment. Please ask for one by using our [online request](#) and well ahead of your visit!

**Throughout August and the first two weeks of January, the archives and the library are completely closed for stocktaking, and holdings cannot be used at all.** Researchers are therefore requested to plan their project schedules accordingly.
